



Adopting a Whole Family Approach to Domestic Abuse and Promoting Safety - Professional Level Workshop

This course considers the diverse range of people affected by domestic abuse and its impact; thinking about the different dynamics present in abusive relationships; looking at specific issues related to victims and perpetrators; and exploring interventions to reduce risk including systemic safety planning.

By the end of the *'foundation'* eLearning and 2 day 'professional' workshop course participants will feel more confident to promote safety and change for victims, perpetrators and children. Specifically participants will:

- Have a contemporary understanding of the range of different behaviours that can constitute domestic abuse.
- Have an understanding of the potential impact of domestic abuse on adults and the whole family.
- Have knowledge of legislation, safety planning principles and processes when working with suspected domestic abuse cases including DASH and risk indicator checklist (RIC).
- Be able to apply knowledge of the role of other professionals in the identification of both adult and child need and prevention of risk when planning interventions.
- Have considered how this knowledge can be applied to work with the whole family involved in domestic abuse, including perpetrators where appropriate, to develop and implement a Safety Plan.

All participants must complete three short *'foundation'* eLearning modules in advance of attending the two day workshop. These are:

- Domestic Abuse: What is Domestic Abuse? (Module 1 of 3)
- Domestic Abuse: Impact and building resilience, and barriers to seeking support (Module 2 of 3)
- Domestic Abuse: risk identification, assessment and management (Module 3 of 3)
